1. What do you think this means? *Every disciple is a convert, but not every convert is a disciple.*
2. How do you describe a “biblical disciple”?
3. How have you been personally impacted by the modeling of other Christians? Has it had a positive or negative impact on your life?
4. What do you believe should be the anticipated spiritual results of healthy discipleship? Why?
5. Based on your experience, what are some motivators that cause believers to make a Lordship decision?
6. How do you feel about this statement:
It is the Holy Spirit’s job to coordinate crisis, and my responsibility to be available to Him when He wants to use me in the life of another who is responding to Him.
7. Are you currently spiritually mentoring? If so, where did your mentee “come from”? Are you praying for discernment for your next mentee?
8. We as disciple-maker leaders should be aware of the four Target Groups for mentoring (Chart on the back).

Group 2 – People experiencing crisis and living in the spiritual desert experience, are often more open to Christ’s Lordship. How do we discern (in a Covid-19 environment), if people are living in the spiritual desert?
